
1. Begin with square, colored side up. Fold and unfold along one diagonal.



2. Make pinches along the midpoints of the top and right edges and a short pinch in the middle of the square.




3. Fold the bottom corner up to the pinch along the top edge and unfold, making the crease sharp only where shown.




4. Fold the left edge to the center point, making the crease sharp only where it crosses the mark you just made.







5. Repeat steps 3-4 on the opposite side of the diagonal.



**6.** Fold the lower left corner up to the top edge so that the bottom edge goes through the midpoint of the right side, making a pinch along the right. Unfold.




7. Make a fold from the upper left corner to the mark you just made, pinching where it crosses the diagonal. Unfold.




8. Fold the left edge to the point you just made and unfold, creasing all the way across the square.







9. Repeat steps 6-8 on the opposite side of the diagonal.



10. Fold two corners to the center and unfold, making a pinch where each fold crosses an existing crease.




11. Bring the upper right corner to the intersection shown, making the fold sharp below the diagonal of the square.




12. Bring the lower right corner to the intersection shown, making the fold sharp between two existing creases.







13. Repeat steps 11–12 on the opposite side of the diagonal.



14. Make four pinches along the edges.




15. Connect 5 points with creases.




16. Add four more creases.







17. Add six more creases.



18. Add two more creases. Turn the paper over.




19. Bisect each angle of eight triangles.




20. Bisect each angle of six more triangles.







21. Bisect each angle of six more triangles.



22. Fold the corner up on the existing crease.




23. Collapse the paper on the existing folds, extending some of them to the edge; don't make the extensions sharp. Rotate.



24. Inside petal-fold the top layer.







**25.** Reverse-fold on the existing creases.

**37.** Form a petal fold with some extra paper attached.





**38.** Flatten the petal-fold, spreading layers at the bottom, and swing the excess flap to the left.











**46.** Squash-fold the corner upward while opening out a pocket toward the bottom. The model will not lie flat.




47. Invert the point and fold it up. The model will still not lie flat.




**48.** Squash the paper up and over to the right.
